Each year, Chatelech Secondary School offers its students the opportunity to participate in school activities. Student Voice, teachers, parents and administrators volunteer their time in support of these events. This Event Agreement was created by students, parents, school staff and administration and by signing the form, parents and students acknowledge and understand that the school expects all event participants to follow all school rules.

Unfortunately, some students see this type of activity as an opportunity to break school rules by attending while under the influence or bringing alcohol or drugs to the event. Specifically regarding dances, every attempt is made to screen the participants before being allowed to enter. The students are searched and, in most times, the RCMP are in attendance. Unfortunately, we continue to see a few students break the rules.

To that end, it was suggested that parents discuss with their son or daughter what the school's concerns are and jointly sign an Event Agreement so that all parties are informed about school expectations and the following consequences.

**Bringing a Guest to an Event:** If your son or daughter want to bring a guest to an event, your son or daughter accepts full responsibility of the guest's behaviors and are subject to all consequences of this agreement. Should your son or daughter and/or guest be found in possession of or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs:

First Offense:	Second Offense:
1a. Lose dances for one calendar year, starting at time of offenses	2a. Lose all extra-curricular fieldtrips and participation on sports teams
1b. Participate in 10 hours of volunteer work with Chatelech Student Voice (cannot be counted towards volunteer hours for Graduation Transition)	2b. Participate in an additional 15 hours of volunteer work with Student Voice (cannot be counted towards volunteer hours for Graduation Transition)
1c. Receive 3-5 days out-of-school suspension	2c. Receive 5 days out-of-school suspension
1d. The parent will be contacted and the student will be picked up by the parent or parent designate immediately (student will not be allowed to drive)	2d. Referred to a drug and alcohol counselor 2e. Lose Prom and Grad Banquet

We have read the consequences described above and he/she has acknowledged and understood the school rules, including the consequences, regarding drugs and alcohol.
